These are the familiar pink prawns. Various species of the Penaeidae family are used. They are caught in the coastal areas of South America and Asia. These smaller prawns are peeled and frozen directly after the catch. The small digestive tract is not removed.

- Scientific name: Penaeidae
- Origin: India, Vietnam, Indonesia
- Flavour: Slightly salty
- Characteristics: Smaller, curved pink prawns
- Available: All year round
- Catch method: Wild catch, caught with trawl nets
- Catch Season: Whole year
- Available in: Raw, Blanched, Cooked
