Vannamei shrimps are tropical prawns that are farmed in areas near the equator, generally along the coast in artificial ponds. This farming is increasingly being certified as sustainable in accordance with the GlobalGAP, BAP or ASC standard. Under ideal conditions, the prawns can grow up to a length of 20 centimeters. These prawns are extremely popular and gaining more and more popularity.

- Flavour: Sweet, meaty
